the food tent. Steve Schmiedlin will be in charge of the shuttle service for the Artists. Sign up sheets will be available.

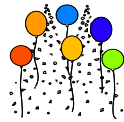
Hope everyone is in good health, and see you all at the meetings in August. Bill Peebles has set up the speakers for August. Pres. Jim
