We are still waiting to hear how we did. Announcement will be made at their annual awards dinner coming soon.

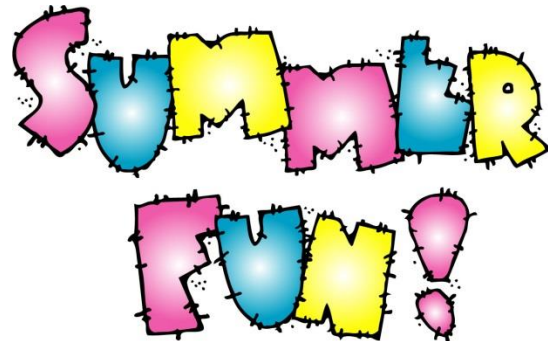
