OASD GLOBAL SERVICE LEARNING PROGRAM

June 22nd is our youth opportunity work day! We will be working with Nature Hill 7-8th grade students as they proceed with their Service Learning Program.

We have been in touch with John Kelliher, director of Parks, Recreation, and Forestry for the city of Oconomowoc. We have identified the opportunity of developing walking trails in Oerling Park, which is on the opposite side of the river from Riverside Park.

The city will mark the trail to be developed, will supply a truck with wood chips, and provide some necessary equipment. The students, along with the help of Kiwanis, will clear the brush and trees and cover the area with the wood chips. Nineteen students have signed up. We need eight Kiwanians willing to work with the students that
