Margaret will let me know what they will be doing with their annual flower and plant sale. Always great flowers.

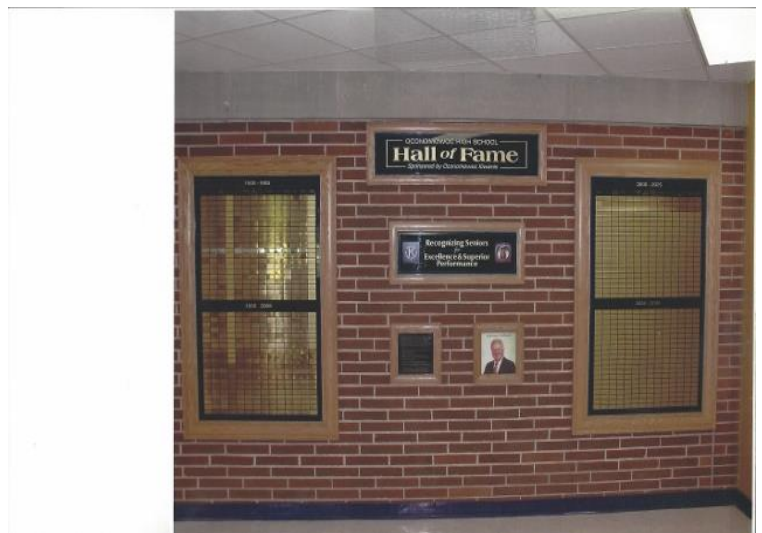
HALL OF FAME DINNER

Following is a brief history of the Hall of Fame especially for our new members.

THE HALL OF FAME AWARD WAS CREATED BY THE OCONOMOWOC HIGH SCHOOL STAFF AND THE OCONOMOWOC KIWANIS EVENING CLUB IN MAY 1966. THE AWARD HONORS SENIOR STUDENTS THAT DISPLAY EXCELLENCE AND SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE IN CITIZENSHIP AND ACADEMICS THROUGHOUT THEIR HIGH SCHOOL YEARS. A SENIOR STUDENT IS SELECTED FROM EACH EDUCATION DEPARTMENT. THE STUDENTS ARE RECOGNIZED EACH YEAR AT AN AWARDS DINNER ATTENDED BY FAMILY MEMBERS, HIGH SCHOOL STAFF AND KIWANIS MEMBERS. THE OCONOMOWOC KIWANIS BREAKFAST CLUB CONTINUED THIS AWARD IN 2003 AFTER THE EVENING CLUB DISBANDED. IN 2005 THE HALL OF FAME WAS DEDICATED TO THE MEMORY OF CARL MUELLER, A MEMBER WHO

WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN THE GROWTH AND SUCCESS OF THE CLUB.

HIGHWAY CLEAN UP

Our 22nd annual tree sale will be held on Saturday May 23rd starting at 8:00 AM to sold out. Help will be needed that day at the Piggly Wiggly site and the BP site in Ixonia. I will send out a sign up sheet. Six to 8 people should be good at each site. The past few years we sold out by about 10AM. I am picking up the trees on Thursday so we plan to do the preorders on Friday mid morning. We have already sold 962 trees out of the 2200 we have. Small white pines almost gone 50 left as of today. Many orders for 25/50 so that will save time on prepackaging. Also many coming to pick them

up on Friday evening by my place so we don't have to transport them on Saturday morning.

I will send a separate email with the flyer/order form for you to print and post if you are somewhere it could be posted. Also share with your friends. Have them call me to place the order.

FFA BANQUET

Another meeting cancelled due to the virus. Spoke with Marge and we are working on some names for awards. Also thanks to the generous donation of \$5000.00 by Bill Peebles we are looking at doing 5- \$1000.00 scholarships to present and former FFA students that are doing continuing education in the AG field. We are checking out the names now. This is all being done in the memory of Bill's wife Allene.
